Take the Ennistymon Road to **Inagh (N85)**, then left to **Milltown Malbay (R460)**.

In **Milltown Malbay** take the road for **Kilrush (N67)**. One mile outside the town, turn right for **Spanish Point (R482)**.

Ibricken Lodge is the **fourth** house on **left** after the **Armada Hotel**.

Public Transport:

Buses and trains run at regular intervals from Limerick to Ennis, daily. One bus from Ennis to Kilkee, via Spanish Point, at 3pm daily. Return bus from Spanish Point to Ennis at 8a.m (approx). Check with Bus Station before travelling.
